Family Promise of Gloucester County has had yet another successful year! We have built new partnerships with congregations and agencies in the community while working alongside our current supportive and dedicated volunteers. Thanks to our large network, 17 families (32 parents and 28 children) will have graduated from our program by the end of the year. Three of our families were successful thanks to the generosity of St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Clarksboro and their gift of St. Peter's Haven Transitional House. Our families are very appreciative and would like to say "thank you" to all who showed them love and kindness when they were at their lowest point. Merry Christmas & Happy Hanukkah! We look forward to helping even more families on 2020.

**Family Success Story**

A family of six from Salem County reached out to Family Promise when they had no one else to turn because they wanted to stay together as a family. They stated that the other shelters/programs would only take mom and children and she would have to leave behind her husband. That all changed when they called Family Promise. Our program keeps families together until they can get back on their feet. The family had lost their apartment when dad was laid off from his job. They were all living in single motel room paying \$65 per night. The family successfully graduated our program within 3 months! They had saved enough money to buy a car and furnish their own three bedroom home back in Salem County. We have adopted them for Thanksgiving and also got the entire family adopted for Christmas. We wish them continued success in their new home and will forever carry them in our hearts.

**Student Transportation Program**

We are excited to announce that we began our new student transportation program this September. Thanks to a grant from the Columbia Bank Foundation, we were able to purchase a 2015 minivan which we have registered as a school vehicle. We also hired a former graduate, who happened to be a school bus driver. We are now able to provide transportation for our kids to their sending school districts. We are hoping to expand the program by adding 4 more vehicles in 2020. The program will not only serve a need for our organization and the community, it will generate much needed revenue to help more families.
